The club is bound by the terms of its licence to implement certain limitations on the consumption of alcohol. These are as follows:

- No alcohol or glass containers are to be brought to the field.
- No consumption of any liquor other than that bought from the canteenis permitted.
- Alcohol is to be consumed in the designated area around the canteen.
- Alcohol consumption in the car park and surrounding areas will not be tolerated.
- No alcohol is to be supplied to persons under the age of 18.
- Any person considered to be intoxicated will be refused service and asked to leave the fields. Failure to comply will result in notification to NSW Police.
- Alcohol consumption is not permitted prior to 5:30pm.
